Commemorative Brick Campaign



The Friends of the Bernardsville Public Library is reinstating its commemorative brick program to raise funds for special library needs. The original brick campaign, a successful part of the New Library Building Campaign, seeded the funding to construct our new library.

Funds from the campaign will go toward library needs including:

- Expansion of library resources to include special children's books, special interests and language material, music downloading facility, etc.
- Installation of computer station to assist the disabled, plus computer hardware and special purpose software, an outside kiosk to expand library capability, etc.
- Provision of ongoing, longer range programs, such as "English as a Second Language" classes, museum lecture series, and an Endowment Funding Program to generate long-term income for specific uses or general operating support.

A purchase of bricks allows permanent recognition of family members, commemoration of family or friends or celebration of a milestone, while helping the library provide outstanding services to the community. Bricks can be purchased in several ways – as an individual or family, as a group, or as a gift or a memorial. Make a lasting mark on your community.
