COVID FAQ Corner

Q: Is wearing two masks better protection?

A: The best mask is one that can be worn comfortably and consistently. While it is possible that wearing two masks may give some people more protection, wearing one mask is much better than wearing none. Be sure that mask is made of breathable fabric and covers both the mouth and nose.

Q: Why are schools still quarantining students for 14 days after exposure if the CDC lowered the quarantine period to 7 or 10 days?

A: <u>According to the CDC and the NJDOH</u>14 days is always preferred as the best way to prevent COVID-19 transmission. The NJDOH also recommends when COVID-19 transmission is High or Very High (orange or red CALI score) exposed close contacts should quarantine for 14 days. When the COVID-19 transmission risk is Moderate or Low (yellow or green CALI score) the CDC recommended shortened timeframes are acceptable alternatives. Check with your local school district to find out their specific policies regarding quarantine.

Bernards Township Vaccine Clinic Updates

The Bernards Township Health Department (BTHD) has been working for months on becoming a COVID-19 vaccine site. We are pleased to inform you that last week the health department was approved as a small vaccination site. At this time, we are currently not scheduling appointments because we were informed by the New Jersey State Health Department that due to a vaccine shortage we cannot place orders for the vaccine. While we are disappointed, as soon as we can order vaccine and schedule appointments, residents will be able to sign up. We are anticipating a March start date for clinics. **Please do not call the office as we are overwhelmed with calls.** All information will be posted on <u>www.bernardshealth.org</u> and sent out via RAVE alerts under "Emergent Public Health Alerts".

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED! Both medical and non-medical volunteers over the age of 18 are needed. Possible tasks include giving injections (if qualified), directing crowds, manning a help desk, and registering participants. Smell Training After COVID-19

While much research is still being done to determine the short- and long-term effects of COVID-19, one of the most notable attributes to those who have tested positive for COVID-19 is the loss of taste and smell. Because the virus crosses the blood-brain barrier and enters the central nervous system (as opposed to just staying in the nasal passages) it affects the neural connections necessary to detect odor and interpret it.

Some homemade remedies have gone viral like the charred oranges on Tik Tok. "Smell training" has been mentioned in the news recently because a group of olfactologists (doctors who study smell) have recommended it. Smell training involves utilizing different strong smells to stimulate the turnover of specialized nerve cells to help restore smell function.
